The Comparative Counterterrorism Project (CCTP) dataset provides cross-national information on counterterrorism law enforcement, legislation, and border security changes from 2016-2019. The unit of observation in the dataset is the country-year. Information was collected using the United States (U.S.) Department of State's annual Country Report on Terrorism. Only countries included in a report from 2016-2019 are included in the dataset. Each observation includes any terror group name(s) included in the report to allow merging CCTP with other datasets using country-year or non-state actor/terror group name.

The U.S. Department of State's Country Report on Terrorism contains several chapters. For the CCT Dataset v1.0 only Chapter 1-Country Reports on Terrorism and Chapter 2-State Sponsors of Terrorism were used. In Chapter 1, individual country reports are divided into several sections. For data collection, three sections of Chapter 1 were used: 1) Overview, 2) Terrorist Incidents, and 3) Legislation, Law Enforcement, and Border Security. Chapter 2 also contains individual country reports, but is not divided into specific sections and therefore, each country report was read and relevant information overlapping the three sections in Chapter 1 was extracted and coded.

The year government CT actions were taken or not. The U.S. State Department's Country Reports on Terrorism are released during the year following the collected information, i.e., the 2019 Report was released in June 2020.

CTchange

Indicator (0=no, 1=yes): Are there any significant changes to CT this year?

Significant changes can include new laws/legislations, amended laws/legislation, new CT units/agencies, or other changes made by the government.

An example of a country-year with a significant CT change, but no new or amended laws or new CT units reported in the source document is the United Kingdom (UK) 2018. CTchange =1 because in June 2018 the UK released an updated counterterrorism strategy document – CONTEST – which had not been revised since 2011.

Text description of the change(s) made by the government in the year of observation. This is left blank if there are no changes reported.

newCTunit

Indicator (0=no, 1=yes): Was there a new CT organization(s) this year?

If a CT operation is mentioned in the report, this is the date of the first mentioned operation. The dates in the *CToperation* are not necessarily chronological. This should not be taken as an indication of preference, severity, or success of the operations.

The date can include a specific day or only the month depending on the information provided in the U.S. Terrorism Country Report.

CToperation2_date

If there was a second CT operation mentioned in the report, this is the date of the second mentioned operation. The dates in the *CToperation* are not necessarily chronological. This should not be taken as an indication of preference, severity, or success of the operations.

CT_investigations_opened

Count: The number of terrorism/CT investigations opened in the country-year of observation. Only counts new investigations, ongoing or old investigations mentioned in the report are not coded.

CT_investigations_closed

Count: The number of terrorism/CT investigations closed in the country-year of observation. If report mentioned investigations closed in previous years, they are not coded.

Terror_suspects_arrested

Count: The number of terrorism suspects arrested in the country-year of observation. Only counts new arrests, old arrests mentioned in the report are not coded.

Investigations_govt_agent

Text Description: What government organization(s) or agency(ies) are responsible for investigations? Lists all government organization(s) or agency(ies) reported as leading or conducting investigations or arrests.

Listed government agents do not have to be responsible for the new investigations or arrests. If information is provided about ongoing investigations or old arrests, the government agent is recorded.

This information can be coded whether the Report includes a specific number of investigations or arrests in the country-year of observation. The number of actions is a distinct measure from the responsible agent. And vice-versa, the Report can include information on the number of investigations or arrests without determining or assigning responsibility to a specific government agent.

This is left blank if there were no investigations or arrests reported. Coded as -99 if new investigations or arrests were reported, but this information is missing in the report.

Prosecuted_terror_cases

Count: The number of terrorism cases where prosecution was completed in the country-year of observation. Only counts completed/closed cases in the country-year of observation, old closed cases mentioned in the report are not coded.

Terror_cases_in_court

Count: The number of terrorism cases in trial (ongoing/active cases in court) in the country-year of observation. Different from other justice system count variables, this counts **all** ongoing cases and **not** only new trials.

Terror_cases_waiting_trial

Count: The number of terrorism cases ready for or awaiting trial in the country-year of observation. Different from other justice system count variables, this counts **any** case awaiting trial.

Terror_charges_opened

Count: The number of terrorism cases opened in the country-year of observation. Only counts newly opened cases in the country-year of observation, old cases mentioned in the report are not coded.

Dismissed_cases_or_charges

Count: The number of terrorism cases dismissed in the country-year of observation. Only counts dismissed cases in the country-year of observation, old cases mentioned in the report are not coded.

Charges_cases_govt_agent

Text Description: What government organization(s) or agency(ies) are responsible for investigations? Lists all government organization(s) or agency(ies) reported as leading or conducting investigations or arrests.

Listed government agents do not have to be responsible for the new investigations or arrests. If information is provided about ongoing investigations or old arrests, the government agent is recorded.

This information can be coded whether the Report includes a specific number of investigations or arrests in the country-year of observation. The number of actions is a distinct measure from the responsible agent. And vice-versa, the Report can include information on the number of investigations or arrests without determining or assigning responsibility to a specific government agent.

This is left blank if there were no investigations or arrests reported. Coded as -99 if new investigations or arrests were reported, but this information is missing in the report.

All_mentioned_govt_CT_agents

Text Description: List of all government organizations, agencies, ministries, or units reported as responsible for CT. These can be general responsibility and does not need to be attributed to a specific operation or mission in the country-year being coded.

This is left blank if none were mentioned in the Report.

CT_description_txt

Text Description: Contains information on and description of CT, law enforcement agencies, and/or CT practices in the country-year Report. This can include one word, very short phrases and direct quotes from the Report. Words or phrases are separated by semi-colons. If multiple words or phrases are included, the order **does not** imply preference or hierarchy, it **reflects** the report's narrative and is only a chronological ordering of where the description occurs in the report.

If no descriptions are included in the Report, this is left blank.

Categorical: Classifies the text description of CT into generalized categories. If multiple words or phrases are included in the text description variable used to create the categorical variables, the order **does not** imply preference or hierarchy, it **reflects** the report's narrative and is only a chronological ordering of where the description occurs in the report. This can include one word, very short phrases and direct quotes from the Report. Words or phrases are separated by semi-colons. If multiple words or phrases are included, the order **does not** imply preference or hierarchy, it **reflects** the report’s narrative and is only a chronological ordering of where the description occurs in the report.

If no descriptions are included in the Report, this is left blank.

If the country repatriated FTFs, but information on where they were repatriated from is missing it is coded as -77.

Agencyagenciesresponsiblefo

Text: List of government organizations, ministries, or agencies responsible for deporting foreign terrorist fighters.

If the country repatriated FTFs, but information on where they were repatriated from is missing it is coded as -77.

citizenshiprevocation

Indicator (0=no, 1=yes): Did the country practice citizenship revocation in the year of observation?

citizen_revocation_number

Count: How many cases of citizenship revocation occurred in the country-year?

If citizen revocation occurred, but the Report does not include a specific number of cases it is coded as -77.
